Volunteer Opportunities

Nutrition Program

- 1) Clerical – assist Nutrition department with general office work (filing, copying, data entry, etc.).
- 2) Site Aide – assist Site Managers with the day-to-day operation of the Congregate Nutrition Sites to set up, serve, clean up and help package homebound meals for delivery.



- 3) Deliver meals to homebound elderly and disabled persons Monday – Friday during the noontime. Great opportunity for retirees, church groups, service organizations and other civic clubs, and local businesses.

Transportation Program

- 1) Clerical – assist Transportation Manager with general office work (filing, copying, data entry, etc.).

Administration

- 1) Clerical – assist Administrative staff with general office work (filing, copying, data entry, mailings, etc.)



- 2) Serve as Receptionist at the Administrative office to greet visitors, answer the phone, and provide clerical assistance Monday – Friday (1/2 day shifts 8:00 AM–4:30 PM).

- 3) Special Events:

- A. Senior Games of Indiana (late May to early June)
- B. Horseshoe Cake-Off (late March)
- C. Senior Citizens Angel Tree Holiday project (November– December).

Long Term Care Ombudsman

- 1) Assist the Area 14 Ombudsman (patient advocate) with activities such as visiting local nursing homes & other facilities, replenish informational materials, follow up with clients whose cases were settled, talk with residents to advise them about Ombudsman services and Resident Rights, monitor general conditions of facility and report activities. Certification & training provided.
