LifeSpan Resources receives grant to perform outreach in Scott County, Indiana.

A \$500 grant from United Way of Scott County was awarded to LifeSpan Resources, Inc., to help the organization perform outreach to community members in Scott County to promote awareness of services and support for families with medically fragile children.

“Many people know LifeSpan as the agency that takes care of older adults, but they don’t realize we have a range of services, programs and resources to support children with high medical needs,” said Lora Clark, CEO.

The outreach efforts will target professionals and families in Scott County to raise awareness of the help that is available. Children with serious medical needs and their families can be connected to in-home services and supports through LifeSpan Resources. These services can allow the child to remain living successfully at home with family members, instead of relocating to an institutional setting.

The grant will allow LifeSpan staff to extend beyond their normal outreach to include schools, libraries, early childhood organizations, and health care facilities and events, to promote the services available for children.
