#### **Diversity and Inclusion Committee Update**




#### C Pugh

#### **HEAT STROKE AND EXHAUSTION: KNOW THE SIGNS**

#### **HEAT STROKE & HEAT EXHAUSTION**

*Heat stroke* is the most serious heat-related illness. Body temperature may rise to 106°F or higher within 10–15 minutes. It can cause death or permanent disability if emergency treatment is not provided. *Heat exhaustion* is less severe, more common, and occurs when the body becomes severely dehydrated. If left untreated, it leads to heat stroke. If you suspect a person is having a problem with the heat, get them to shade and begin cooling with water spray, fans, cool compresses, sips of cool water and call 911.

#### SIGNS OF HEAT STROKE

- High body temperature (above 103°F)
- Red, hot, dry skin (no sweating)
- Rapid, strong pulse
- Throbbing headache
- Dizziness, nausea, confusion
- Unconsciousness

#### SIGNS OF HEAT EXHAUSTION

- Heavy sweating, cold, clammy skin
- Dizziness or fainting
- A weak and rapid pulse
- Muscle cramps
- Fast, shallow breathing
- Nausea, vomiting or both



#### WHAT TO DO:

- Have someone call 911 while you begin cooling the person
- Monitor body temperature; continue cooling efforts until body temperature drops to 101–102°F.
- If emergency medical personnel are delayed, call the ER for further instructions.

#### FEMA OFFERS FUNERAL ASSISTANCE

#### FEMA Offering Funeral Assistance to Those Affected by COVID-19

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought overwhelming grief to many families. FEMA is dedicated to helping ease some of the financial stress and burden caused to people before, during and after disasters; including the pandemic.

FEMA is offering financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020. To be eligible for funeral assistance, you must meet the following criteria:

- $\Rightarrow$  The death must have occurred in the U.S., including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia
- ⇒ The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to or caused by COVID-19
- $\Rightarrow$  The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national or qualified alien.

Eligible expenses may include, but not limited to:

- ⇒ Transportation for up to two people to identify the deceased individual
- ⇒ The transfer of remains, a casket or urn
- ⇒ A burial plot or cremation niche
- ⇒ A marker or headstone
- ⇒ Clergy or officiant services
- ⇒ Cremation or interment costs
- ⇒ Costs associated with producing multiple death certificate

#### **SUMMER FUN!**

#### No-Bake Strawberry Blueberry Trifle

**Prep Time:** 30 minutes **Total Time:** 30 minutes

#### **Ingredients**

17 oz angel food cake cut into 1" cubes (I used 1 1/2 blocks)

1 lb fresh strawberries hulled and sliced

1 lb fresh blueberries

1/4 cup water

2 Tbsp sugar

2 Tbsp lemon juice from 1/2 medium lemon

2 packages 8 oz each cream cheese, softened at room temp

3/4 cup granulated sugar

2 cups heavy whipping cream

1/2 tsp vanilla extract

#### What you will need:

4 or 5 qt trifle dish or make it in a 9x13 casserole dish.

#### **Directions:**

In a measuring cup, combine 1/4 cup water, 2 Tbsp sugar and 2 Tbsp lemon juice and stir until sugar is dissolved. Set aside until needed. Beat together 1 lb cream cheese and 3/4 cup sugar on medium speed until creamy and smooth, scraping the bowl a couple times. With mixer on, pour in 2 cups heavy cream then turn mixer to medium/high and continue beating until whipped and fluffy. Add 1/2 tsp vanilla and beat until incorporated. Place 1/3 of your sliced angel food cake into the bottom of your trifle dish and brush with 1/3 of your syrup. Add 1/3 of your cream and loosely spread it over cake pieces. Add 1/2 of the sliced strawberries. Repeat with remaining ingredients (adding 1/2 of the blueberries for the second fruit layer). Frost the top with last 1/3 of cream and decorate with remaining fruit.
